# Dr. M. Anandaraj joins as Director, IISR, Kozhikode



Dr. M. Anandaraj, a renowned Plant Pathologist and Project Coordinator (Spices) has taken over as the new Director of Indian Institute of Spices Research, Kozhikode (Calicut) w.e.f. 4 July 2011. Dr. Anandaraj joined ICAR in 1978 as Scientist and since then he has been serving the Council in various capacities. Currently he is also the National Coordinator of the ICAR Outreach "Phytophthora, Project on Fusarium and Ralstonia diseases of horticultural and field crops". He is well known for his contributions on epidemiology and management of Phytophthora foot rot and his pioneering work on biological control of Phytophthora. To his credit he has 148 publications besides 19 books/monographs/chapters. He also served as Editor of six books on spices and has also for contributed chapters

UNESCO-EOLSS (Encyclopedia of life support system). Dr. Anandaraj has guided 5 Ph.D and 16 M.Sc students under Calicut University, Mangalore University and Nagarjuna University. He represented India in International Pepper Community, and has been Jakarta. empanelled as a member to draft Good Agricultura! Practices for black pepper.

A recipient of Dr.J.S. Pruthy Award (three times) and Dr.C.S. Venkat Ram Award, Dr. Anandaraj is currently the President of Indian Society for Spices and Fellow of the following professional Societies: National Academy of Biological Sciences, Phytopathological Society of India, Indian Society for Spices, Indian Society for Plantation Crops, Indian Society for Seed Spices and Society for Advancement of Biological Control.

# **Research update**

**Germplasm enrichment** During the period under report, 103 accessions of black pepper were collected from coastal regions of Alleppey district and 92 accessions of wild relatives of *Piper* from the forests of Idukki Wild Life Sanctuary and added to the germplasm repository.

**Mechanisation of farm operation** A machine was fabricated in collaboration with Central Institute of Agricultural Engineering, Regional Station, Coimbatore for mixing and vending potting mixture for spices nursery.

# Banana Bract mosaic virus infecting cardamom

The association of BBrMV with symptomatic cardamom plants was con-



firmed by RT-PCR and electron microscopy.

# Survey on rhizome and root rot pathogens of cardamom

Surveys carried out in Wayanad and Idukki districts of Kerala, Valparai in Tamilnadu, and Hassan and Kadogu districts of Karnataka for rhizome and root rot pathogens of cardamom indicated that Meppadi Parichayath in Wayanad district is a hot spot for the disease.

Sixty fungi including *Rhizoctonia solani*, *Fusarium* oxysporum, *Fusarium solani*, *Colletotrichum* sp., *Pythium vexans* and *Botryodiplodia theobromae* were isolated from the rhizome and root rot affected cardamom plants.

#### Natural resistance against leaf spot disease of cardamom

Studying 328 germplasm accessions of cardamom under natural conditions resulted in identifying two accessions, namely, IC-349613 and IC-349588, highly resistant to the disease.

#### Efficient Trichoderma isolate

Among the thirty two *Trichoderma spp.*, WYD T11, the *Trichoderma harzianum* isolate obtained from the rhizosphere of black pepper was found promising and also compatible with metalaxyl + mancozeb.

#### Protocol for DNA isolation

A protocol was standardized for total DNA extraction from the fungal colony, cultured on potato dextrose agar and potato dextrose broth.

# Transfer of Technology

#### Training on laboratory techniques

A short-term training on 'Isolation and Identification of Soil-borne Fungi and Nematodes Associated with Black Pepper' was organized at IISR, Calicut during 13-18 June 2011. Five research personnel of the Sugandhi project attended the programme.

#### PhytoFuRa training

Indian Institute of Spices Research, Calicut, hosted a training programme on Application of Genomics and Bioinformatics in Phytophthora/Ralstonia Research during 8-17 February. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. V. A Parthasarathy, Director. The training was conducted in two phases: Phase 1 covered Basics of Molecular Biology and Bioinformatics and Phase 2 dealt with Genomics and Proteomics. Seventeen Research fellows and one Scientist working in PhytoFuRa project participated in the training programme. Apart from the faculties of the Institute, Dr. R. Vishwanathan, SBI, Coimbatore, Dr. Vinod Scaria, IGIB, New Delhi, Dr. A. Kumar, IARI, New Delhi & Dr. R. Ramesh, ICAR-RC, Goa, also delivered lectures.

#### Training of extension functionaries

Two training courses on production and post harvest technology of ginger and turmeric sponsored by the Maharashtra and Punjab State Horticulture Mission schemes were conducted during January and March 2011 respectively, in which 28 progressive farmers participated. Under the Horticulture Mission for North Eastern and Himalayan States, one training workshop on *Production and post harvest technology of spices in Assam* was organized at CPCRI station, Kahikuchi, in March 2011. One orientation training programme for the newly recruited scientific and field staff was organized in April 2011.

#### Technology inputs and Advisory services from ATIC

During the period under report, 2040 farmers including 403 from other districts of Kerala and 510 from outside state availed services from the centre through direct visit and 747 students visited the Institute on study tour. Out of the visits recorded, 16 farmers' groups were on exposure visit.

The centre generated Rs. 1,81,696 from the technology inputs including Rs.77540 from planting materials, Rs. 65106 from biocontrol agents and Rs. 3500 from diagnostic services, and Rs. 35550 from sale of publications. The centre also participated in two State-level Exhibition/Kisan Melas.

# Planting material distribution and training for Wayand district of Kerala

Under the consortium based project, 'Multi-enterprise farming models to the address the agrarian crisis of Wayanad District of Kerala funded by NAIP', 15,000 cuttings of IISR varieties of black pepper, namely, *Sreekara, Subhakara* and *IISR Thevam*, and fertilizer inputs were supplied to RARS, Ambalavayal for further multiplication and distribution to farmers. A training programme on IPM and IDM in black pepper and ginger was organized at Wayanad Social Service Society, Mananthavady, on 26 May 2011.

### Documentaries on farmers' success

As part of the NAIP project on *Mobilizing Mass Media Support for Sharing Agro-Information*, two documentary films were produced during the period. *'Prathibha Turmeric: A success story'*, shot in English, Hindi and Malayalam languages, documents the success stories of Mr. P. Abdul Nabeel of Mepayur in Calicut and Mr. Chandra Sekhar Azad of Vijayawada who have been successfully cultivating the turmeric variety *'Prathibha'* for many years.

The second documentary film on 'Broiler Goat Rearing: Women Self Help Group shows the Way' features the success story of Kaveri Self Help Group in Chakkittappara Panchayath of Calicut district in goat rearing with the active intervention of KVK, Calicut.

## Karshika Sankethika Darshanam 2011



The Institute organized a three day Kisan Mela and Agricultural Technology Expo, at the main Campus in Calicut during 27-29 January, 2011 as part of the NAIP Sub-Project, on Mobilizing Mass Media Support for Sharing Agro-Information. Mr K K Raghavan, Joint Rubber Production Commissioner, Rubber Board. Calicut. inaugurated the Mela and Dr V A Parthasarathy, Director, IISR, Calicut, presided over the function. Five innovative farmers, Mr Saji Mathew, Mr P Abdul Nabeel, Mr Binu Mathew and Mr K K Manoj and Smt Revamma Dharanidharan, belonging to different fields of agriculture, were felicitated. Two hundred selected farmers from Kozhikode district attended the Kisan mela. Fourteen research organizations and NGOs from all over the State show-cased their technologies in the exhibition, which attracted public and students.

Thirteenth Scientific Advisory Committee meeting of the Krishi Vigyan Kendra was held at IISR, Calicut on 23 June 2011, under the chairmanship of Dr. V.A.Parthasarathy, Director, IISR, Calicut.

#### Front Line Demonstration

Demonstration of various spice production technologies of IISR, namely, bush pepper cultivation, evaluation of High Yielding Varieties of balck pepper, seed production of HYVs of turmeric, value addition in green pepper – pepper in brine, integrated disease management of Phytophthora foot rot of black pepper and post AI administration of sterile ceftriaxone sodium on conception rate in milch cows, popularisation of tiger shark - Assam Vaala (Pangasius sutchi) for freshwater aquaculture and induced breeding of fresh water fishes using gonadotrophin releasing hormone are in progress, at farmers' fields.

#### **On Farm Testing**

On farm testing trials of performance evaluation of nutmeg variety Viswasree in coconut garden, white pepper production using bacterial fermentation, induction of flowering in Olour Mango through application of paclobutrazol in combination with INM and IPM, fertility in anoestrus cows following controlled Intravaginal Drug Release Device (CIDR), bio-seed assay for pregnancy testing in cattle, GNRH treatment and double AI for management of repeat breeding cows, use of live feed in rearing of ornamental fishes, culture of fresh water fishes using low cost feed and testing of value added products of nutmeg pericarp are at various levels of progress.
